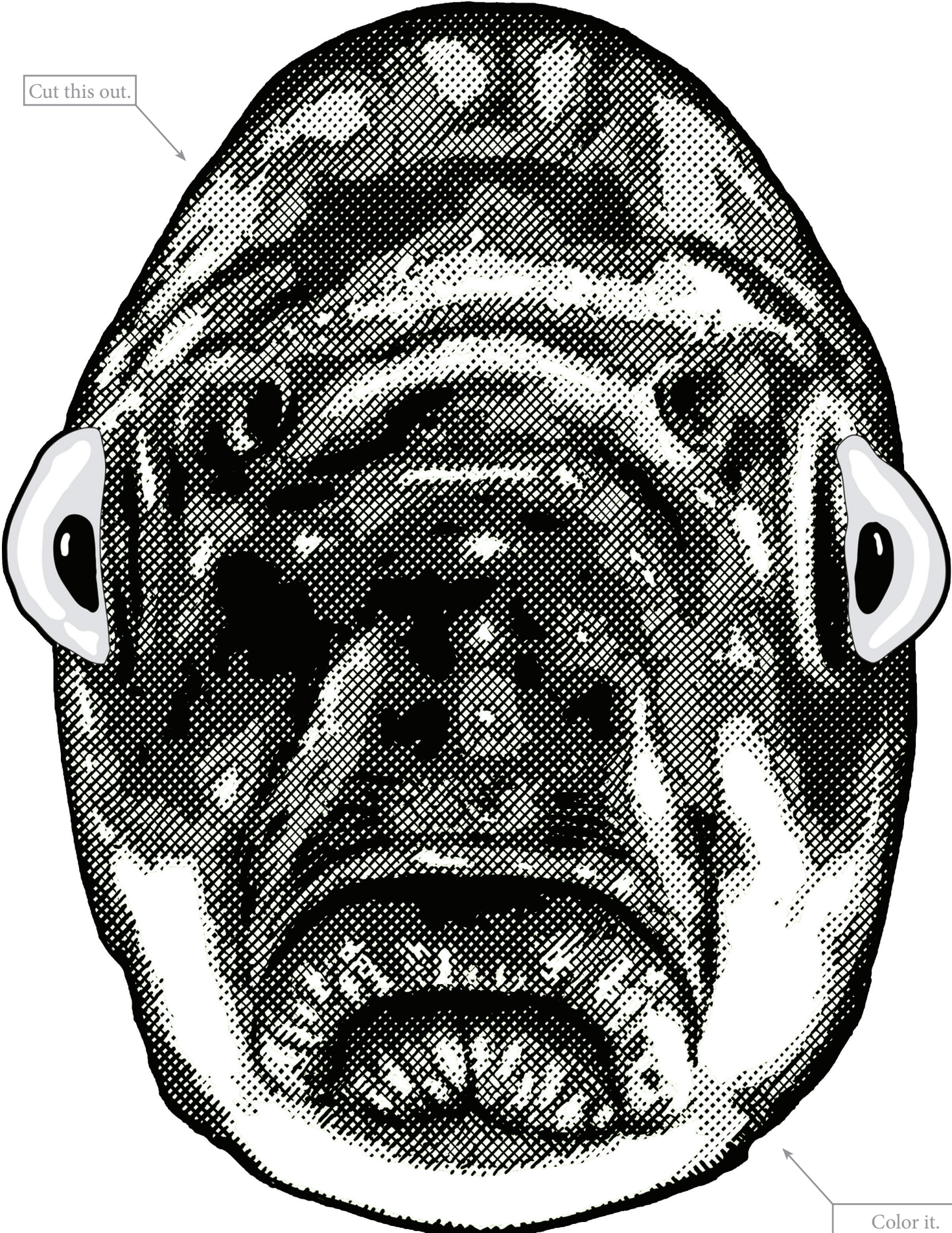
Smallmouth Buffalo (*Ictiobus bubalus*) by Olaf Nelson.

1. Print color or black and white pages (if you don't want the fins, just print the head).
2. Cut out the head and fins.
3. Glue or tape the fins to the back of the head (glue a popsicle stick or something behind them to make them more rigid).
4. Hold the mask in front of your face and figure out where you need eye holes (they won't be where the buffalo's eyes are unless you have a really weird head).
5. Cut eye holes. **NOT WITH THE MASK IN FRONT OF YOUR FACE!**
6. Tape or glue a stick of some sort to the back of the mask (paint stirrer, ruler, etc.), OR attach a rubber band, ribbon, or other strap that you can tie behind your head, OR figure out a way to attach it to a hat.
